About the Cabinetmakers' Autumn Exhibition:

Nanna Ditzel's Trinidad chair, Poul Kjærholm's PK24 and Hans J Wegner's Circle chair all came into the world as experiments in the Cabinetmakers' Autumn Exhibition.

The Cabinetmakers' Autumn Exhibition began in 1981 and is a non-commercial association of furniture manufacturers and designers that is independent of organisations, government and other stakeholders. The association's main purpose is to create and present innovative furniture prototypes once a year. Furniture that is based on an overarching theme, a specific idea or a general framework that has been determined by the Cabinetmakers' Autumn Exhibition for that year, which the members have to cooperate on. Furniture that blazes new trails in new contexts, guided by new ideas. Not as drafts on a sheet of paper but as tangible and feasible prototypes that are ready for use. The usability and the tangible experience of the furniture is a key feature of the Cabinetmakers' Autumn Exhibition, since normally the public is not allowed to sit in or on the exhibits.

The cooperation between manufacturer and designer requires knowledge sharing and respect. Respect for the profession and for each other's professional skills without losing sight of the concrete piece of furniture, because the ambition is to take the works one step further each time. Every year, a team of guest exhibitors are included, because fresh eyes will see new angles and new ways of doing things - and that challenge essentially helps refine the works. The Cabinetmakers' Autumn Exhibition offers a unique professional playground for designers and manufacturers that takes both itself and its products seriously, and where the commercial aspect is not a controlling factor for the furniture design.

Thus, over the past 29 years, the annual Cabinetmakers' Autumn Exhibition has become a recurring event that the public and the press look forward to, as this is the place for spotting the future's new classics and design seeds, and the place where prototypes of potential future blockbusters are introduced. The Cabinetmakers' Autumn Exhibition is proud of the high standards we have maintained. Only time will tell whether some of the works go as far as Ditzel's, Kjærholm's or Wegner's classics, but it remains a fact that the Cabinetmakers' Autumn Exhibition represents the best of the best in contemporary Danish furniture design year after year without commercial constraints. That is a bit of a feat. And then on an entirely voluntary basis...

In response to the growing international interest in the Cabinetmakers' Autumn Exhibition, this year we have established a partnership with the innovation network Development Centre UMT to present the exhibition "Whiteout" in Tokyo in April 2011.

The association's website is also one of the world's largest prototype databases, as it features all the experimenting furniture works from the past 29 years of exhibitions.
